2013 in Review

Over 2,300 new jobs were created and \$283 million in capital investment was made by companies either relocating or expanding their operations in the county.

Schwan Cosmetics USA

The company announced plans to consolidate its U.S. operations by building a state-of-the-art facility in Murfreesboro.
